Fifty-year Rotarian Bob Young said he was glad to be back. Health and transportation issues have kept him away from Dearborn Rotary. He hopes to attend upcoming meetings on a regular basis.

Ray Trudeau said Nicaraguan government just approved Rotary and World Medical Relief to send rebuilt pacemakers to Nicaragua. New pacemakers cost \$5,000 to \$25,000 in the United States and rebuilt pacemakers will be provided to patients in Nicaragua for free. Hospital in Chinandega plus one other will be installing these pacemakers in patients. Ray will be attending a board meeting about how to send rebuilt pacemakers to other countries in need.

Rick Goward encouraged us to attend Big Band, Bop & Pop Concert on Saturday, January 26, 2019 at 8 PM at Ford Performing Arts Center. It is a Dearborn Rotary "no brainer" fundraiser.
