CDG Jim Ives had the opportunity to visit the office of Gus Loehr, one of the first 4 Rotarians. It was his office where the very first Rotary Club meeting took place with Paul Harris, Gus Loehr, Silvester Schiele, and Hiram Shorey. The office was room 711 in the Unity Building (how appropriate a name for a building Rotary would meet in) in Chicago. He was an engineer, and you can see in his office the desk he used, the meeting table he had to work on projects and to have meetings at, as well the motto before Service Above Self. Notice the early version of the Rotary Wheel.

This office was recreated on the first floor of Rotary One, 1560 Sherman Ave., Evanston, IL. I am inspired each time I visit it.
