Past President Young Scholarship

This award is to be presented annually to one or more seniors graduating from one or more of Dearborn's Public High Schools. The maximum number of awards to be granted annually is one per Dearborn Public High School.

The graduating seniors applying for this/these scholarship(s) are to demonstrate through this application and, if applicable, through the interview process that they qualify because of their academic achievement, demonstration of leadership skills, commitment to community service and their understanding and application in their life of the ethical standards found in Rotary's Four Way Test.

The minimum amount of the award annually is \$1,500 with the actual amount of the award(s) to be determined by the Selection Committee in conjunction with the Dearborn Rotary Foundation. This minimum award is to be based on the amount of income earned by the invested funds. The award is to be used for the student's freshman year at an accredited Michigan college or university, and a check will be sent to the college or university the student(s) is/are attending.

Award

The Dearborn Rotary Past President Young Scholarship Award will be in the form of a check sent to the college or university the student is attending and is to be used for the student's freshman year.

Criteria

The student(s) selected by the Dearborn Rotary Club's Selection Committee will exemplify the principles found in Rotary's Four Way Test:

- 1. Is it the TRUTH?**
- 2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?**
- 3. Will it build GOOD WILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?**
- 4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?**

In addition to the above the Selection Committee will base its selection on the student's academic achievement (class standing, GPA, SAT, ACT, Advanced Placement courses as well as financial need. Also, the Selection Committee will review the student's demonstrated leadership skills in school and in the community. Honors and awards will also be considered.

6. Deadline—Applications must be postmarked on or before January 16, 2012. Applications and related materials will not be returned.
