- 18 million people are walking today because of the polio vaccination program.
- Polio only remains in Afghanistan and Pakistan.
- 400 million people are vaccinated each year.
- Polio vaccination cost is only \$3.00 per child for life.

Polio eradication has saved \$40 to \$50 billion in health care costs.

Dearborn Rotary became involved in program when Lee was on President Don Karcher's Board in 1987-1988.

Kathy Kalil, Ph.D with an assist by PE Eric Rader presented certificates to Rotarians who have supported the "My Potential" Mentoring Program. Kathy said students and schools benefited from this program and thanked us for our teamwork and support.
