## Meeting Notes

Today's speaker, Nadine Jones, is the Founder/Director of Love a Michigan Vet Project. This non-profit is dedicated to serving the needs and improving the quality of life for our nation's heroes by providing supportive services to veterans and their families.

The project works closely with the four Veteran's shelters in the Detroit area. The total number of Veteran's housed in all four shelters is 175. The assistance to these shelters includes:

- Serving dinner at one of the shelters monthly.

- Providing necessities such as sheets and blankets.

- A Christmas dinner party at all four shelters for Veteran's and their families.

- Providing winter coats and boots to the children

In addition, the project sends care packages to those serving overseas as well as finding resources to give comfort to the families of those that are deployed.

Nadine concluded by stating that donors and volunteers are always welcome.

Bob Gleichauf shared with Nadine that the club foundation recently added a scholarship to a Veteran pursuing a degree at The University of Michigan-Dearborn. In addition, funds have been provided to support the work of the 19<sup>th</sup> District Court Veterans Court.

President Glenn adjourned the meeting with the recitation of the 4 Way Test.
