## **Hugh Archer Memorial Scholarship Application**

### **Annual College Scholarship Award**

For Graduating Students within the Dearborn School District Public and Private Schools,  
Including DPS Early College Programs and Career Technical Education Programs

This \$4,000 scholarship is presented to two outstanding students currently attending a public or private high school in the Dearborn School District, or attending the DPS Early College or Career Technical Education Programs. The award will be sent to the Financial Aid Office of the student's designated, accredited college or university. The scholarship is in honor of Hugh Archer and his vast contributions as a Rotarian, businessman and humanitarian.

The award is based on the student's academic achievement, demonstration of leadership, community service, and exemplification of ethical standards as depicted in the Rotary Four-Way Test.

*Will it be Beneficial to all concerned?”*

## Application Process

1. Physical Application and Deadline: The application can be downloaded from the scholarship tab on the Dearborn Rotary website ([www.dearbornrotary.org](http://www.dearbornrotary.org)). The student is requested to fill out the application, include the other requested documents and mail the complete packet to the address listed below. Applications **must** be postmarked by the **January 22, 2021 deadline**.

2. Judges: The Chair of the Hugh Archer Scholarship committee and two other appointed Rotarians will act as the judging panel.
3. Notification of Winner: The students who are awarded the scholarship will be notified by both email and by regular mail. All non-award applicants will receive an email with notification that the judging has been completed.
4. Obtaining Scholarship Award: Scholarship award winners must download and submit the *Scholarship Funds Request Form* also found on [www.dearbornrotary.org](http://www.dearbornrotary.org) under the scholarship tab. **The request for funds form must be submitted between July 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year and June 30<sup>th</sup> of the following year. In the event the form is not received by the June 30<sup>th</sup> deadline date, the scholarship will be no longer available.** Funds will be available an additional year for Collegiate Academy students who receive the award in their Senior Year.
5. Celebration: Scholarship award winners will be invited to attend a Rotary Celebration Event dinner in April to receive appropriate recognition.
